Overnight Excursion 1 - Yala National Park Safari and Galle Fort City Tour - 1N/2D

DAY 1: Depart Colombo (8am) and travel (4 hrs.) to the southern jungles of Yala.

After lunch at your hotel, proceed on an afternoon jeep safari (3-6 pm) at Yala National Park.

Yala National Park is the islands most popular and second largest national park affords visitors the opportunity to sight Sri Lanka's broad variety of wildlife; colorful painted storks, sun bathing crocs, lovely fantail peacocks, massive wild buffalos, playful monkeys, majestic elephants, fluffy Sri Lankan sloth bears, a variety of colorful and interesting birdlife and the star attraction; the elusive Sri Lankan leopard. Yala has the highest density of leopards in the world! Nothing is guaranteed when it comes to

wildlife, but a glimpse of a leopard at Yala is a decent possibility, given the large number of leopards that roam these

territories.

Return to your hotel following your safari. Dinner and overnight stay.

Meals: Lunch, dinner

DAY 2: Optional morning safari (6-9am)

After breakfast in Yala, travel (1 1/2 hrs.) to explore the Galle Fort City

Tucked away in a corner sticking out into the ocean is the old Galle Fort City, fortified by a fort, where time has surely slowed down. This UNESCO World heritage site was built in 1600's by the Portuguese followed by an extensive fortification by the Dutch.
